2021-2022 Advocacy Efforts and Advocacy Subgroups

Updated March 10, 2022

The table below outlines issues of interest and concern to CCA that have carried over from the past year and issues that have arisen since the 2020-21 advocacy plan was developed.

At its July 12, 2021 meeting, the CCA Advocacy Committee began initial consideration of these issues, and of forming subgroups to work on the issues (including asking for volunteers) and coordinators for each subgroup. Once formed, the **Advocacy Subgroups** will meet as needed to identify the priorities with each policy issue, develop conceptual solutions, and specify policy proposals to implement the solutions. These will be reported to subsequent CCA Advocacy Committee meetings.

2021 - Housing Security ARPA - Follow up on HB 21-1329, which establishes an interim task force to determine how to make investments in housing to assist persons disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 public health emergency facing housing insecurity. Consider participation in State Housing Coalition. Address needs for home modification/repair.

2021 - Rental-Landlord-Tenants - Follow up on SB 21-173, which improved tenant rights related to residential rental agreements, and HB21-1121, which provides protections for residential tenants related to actions by landlords.

Consider participation in the Renters Roundtable. Also consider landlord perspectives. Investigate use of public land and buildings for affordable housing, house sharing, mobile home parks and homeless housing.
