### **REVIEW OF COMMITTEE PROCEDURES**

The committee will discuss a bill and decide whether to keep it on our list for consideration of a position at the next meeting. Remember, you must be a Member of the Colorado Center for Aging to vote on bills. Every bill we follow must have a volunteer who will take responsibility to follow each bill through the committee hearings and discuss it at the CCA Advocacy Committee Meetings.

Bills will be reviewed and considered for a position of Support, Strongly Support, Oppose, Strongly Oppose, Amend, or Monitor. The committee also may take a position of Support with Amendments or Oppose with Amendments.
