AGENDA FOR MONDAY'S MEETING

REVIEW OF COMMITTEE PROCEDURES

*The committee will discuss a bill and decide whether to keep it on our list for consideration of a position at the next meeting. **Remember, you must be a Member of the Colorado Center for Aging to vote on bills. Every bill we follow must have a volunteer who will take responsibility to follow each bill through the committee hearings and discuss it at the CCA Advocacy Committee Meetings.***

Bills will be reviewed and considered for a position of Support, Strongly Support, Oppose, Strongly Oppose, Amend, or Monitor. The committee also may take a position of Support with Amendments or Oppose with Amendments.

BILL REVIEW AND VOTING ON POSITIONS

There are just three days left in the session and no new Bills have been introduced. But there are still many bills at some stage in the process. At this meeting, we discuss the bills on our main list and their status. We also will have an initial discussion of our plans for after the session.

We have too many bills in our Bill Tracker to follow. We will have to make some difficult decisions at this meeting and delete some of the bills. We have many bills labeled as MONITOR which we need to take a position on or possibly delete from the bill tracker.

- To make the task of reviewing the bills more efficient, we need all members to review the bills before the meeting – see instructions below

REMINDER ABOUT REVIEWING THE BILLS

We have Sixty Nine (69) bills in our CCA Bill Tracker. We cannot follow this many bills, so we need to focus on the bills that have the most impact on older adults.

Please review the list of bills and come prepared to share your top bills that you think we should follow and become involved with. Remember that we will need volunteers to step forward to follow each of the bills we are tracking. Be prepared to get involved in the bill tracking.
