CCA amendments added to the bill in the Senate are (mostly) still in the bill. **The House committee reinstated most of the local control preemptions in the bill as introduced in the Senate. As a result, the CCA board voted to return CCA's original position of Oppose, unless amended. *Our CCA Advocate for this bill is Rich Mauro.*
